# GARBAGE & RECYCLING INFORMATION

### Wednesday is Residential Garbage Collection Day.

All garbage placed into garbage containers for curbside pickup must be in bags. No loose materials are permitted in the garbage containers.

Should a garbage bin have loose material in it, the garbage will not be collected and you will need to rectify for next garbage collection, as long as it does not exceed your permitted volume, or bring to Garbage Depot and pay for disposal.

Garbage should not be placed curbside the night before (this will attract bears and critters and create a mess).

ALL GARBAGE MUST BE IN APPROVED CANS, MAXIMUM OF TWO GARBAGE CANS PER HOUSEHOLD (each container not to exceed 18 kgs.) No loose bags are to be left curbside and No Bungie cords are to be used to secure lids

VILLAGE EMPLOYEES DO NOT PICK-UP EXTRA GARBAGE. It should be taken to the public works yard for a minimum fee of \$5.70. (\$174.70/tonne).

The Public Works Drop Off Depot is located *on Hilke Road,* past the ball fields.

Open Wednesday through Sunday from 9:00 A.M. - 3:45 P.M.

DISPOSAL FEES \$174.70/tonne... minimum charge of \$5.70.

Materials must be separated & disposed in designated areas - General household garbage/construction/wood waste must all be kept separate and disposed of in the designated areas.

Mattresses Only - No box spring	\$15.00/unit
(Box springs are regular garbage disposal rate)	
Automobiles - No rims or tires (Rims are free in metal bin)	\$30.00/per vehicle (tires based on weight)

#### At the Depot:

The Provincial Multi Paper Packaging Program changes and evolves as we move forward, but separate from the Provincial program the Village continues to provide areas for other products to reduce our impact on the landfill.

PUBLIC WORKS DROP-OFF DEPOT HAS AREAS AVAILABLE FOR THE FREE DISPOSAL OF THE FOLLOWING ITEMS:

- Scrap metal does not include tin & aluminum cans that are part of the Material Packaging Program
- Glass any broken windows, picture glass, drinking glasses, plates, ceramics etc.
- Vehicle batteries
- Grass clippings and yard & garden pruning up to 8 inches in diameter accepted
- Paint & Product Care various household paint products
- Light Recycling -Fluorescent lights & lamp Recycling Program
- Small Appliance Recycling
- toaster, microwaves etc.

  White Goods fridges, stoves include tin & aluminum
  and other large appliances
  - cans that are part of the O Electro Recycling Electrical Material Packaging Power Equipment
    - Bulky Equipment Recycling elliptical/treadmill etc.
  - windows, picture glass, o Smoke & Carbon Monoxide drinking glasses, plates, Alarm Recycling
    - Household Batteries & Cell Phones - collected at the Village Office and the Aquatic Center and with the Depot Operator
    - Electronics Recycling computers, printers, other Information Technology (IT) equipment, phones, etc.
