VILLAGE OF GOLD RIVER

Noise Control Amendment Bylaw No. 665.1, 2022

A bylaw to amend the Noise Control Bylaw No. 665, 2008.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Gold River believes:

- a) that certain noises or sounds are objectionable or liable to disturb the quiet, peace, rest, enjoyment, comfort or convenience of individuals or the public; and
- b) that it is desirable to regulate or prohibit the making or causing of noises or sounds in the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Local Government Bylaw Notice Enforcement Act authorizes Council to designate bylaw contraventions that may be dealt with by bylaw notice;

AND WHEREAS the Community Charter including Sections 16, 17, 258, and 260 authorizes Council to allow for enforcement in relation to these matters:

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Gold River, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. That sections 8.1 and 8.2 of the Village of Gold River Noise Control Bylaw No. 665, 2008 be deleted and replaced with:
- 8.1 "Penalties for offences against this bylaw are set out in Schedule "A" of the Village of Gold River Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 737, 2022."
- 8.2 "Penalties may be processed by bylaw notice in accordance with the Village of Gold River Bylaw Notice Enforcement Bylaw No. 737, 2022 or by the municipal ticket information system in accordance with the Village of Gold River Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 704, 2018."
- 2. That section 3.4 be added to the Village of Gold River Noise Control Bylaw No. 665, 2008 as follows:
- 3.4 "Noise complaints set out in sections 3.1 and 3.2 must be supported by at least two separate affected households or businesses. A bylaw officer can waive this requirement if they determine that there is sufficient evidence that an offence occurred or if the bylaw officer witnesses the infraction in addition to the complainant."
