- Engage with Mowachaht/Muchalaht First Nation on a regular basis to consider initiatives and priorities that are mutually beneficial to our communities
- Advocate and cooperate with local and senior governments on regional issues affecting our community

We will work to maintain levels of service that are affordable to support a diverse and vibrant community

- Responsibly review and provide services at levels which the community are willing to pay

Specific Actions

Inter-governmental relations

- Conduct an assessment of recreation facilities within the Village
- Review options regarding leasable spaces at the Public Safety building and the Jack Christenson Centre
- Conduct a structural review of the Jack Christenson Centre

Community livability

- Consideration of an Off Road Vehicle bylaw
- Update the Official Community Plan and Zoning bylaws, including consideration of secondary suites
- Explore locations for the creation of a dog park

• Develop a plan for a tourism marketing partnership
