Open Wednesday to Sunday 9:00 AM - 3:45 PM

Wednesday is **Residential Garbage Collection Day**

All garbage placed into garbage containers for curbside pickup must be in bags; should a garbage bin have loose material; the garbage will not be collected. Garbage should not be placed curbside the night before as this will attract bears create a mess.

Bungie cords are NOT to be used to secure lids.

ALL GARBAGE MUST BE IN APPROVED CANS, MAXIMUM OF TWO GARBAGE CANS PER HOUSEHOLD *each container not to exceed 18 kgs.

DISPOSAL FEES \$201.70/tonne; minimum charge \$10.00

* PLEASE BRING LOOSE OR EXTRA GARBAGE TO DROP-OFF DEPOT FOR REGULAR WASTE DISPOSAL FEE

All Materials must be kept separate and disposed of in the designated areas i.e. general household garbage, construction wood and yard waste.

Solid Waste and Construction Waste	\$201.70 / tonne
Yard Waste – up to 8" diameter accepted	\$65.00 / tonne

Drywall (Gypsum) Diversion:

Due to WorkSafe BC health and safety regulations Comox Strathcona Waste Management (CSWM) facilities will no longer accept per-1990 drywall. All pre-1990 drywall must now be tested for asbestos content and proof of certification is required to be able to deposited at the Gold River Drop Off Depot.
